



WHAT IS RENT CONTROL?

Municipalities within the State may adopt ordinances regulating the amount and frequency of rent increases within their specific municipality.

PURPOSE OF THE RLB:

- Host hearings on complaints from residents involving suspected unlawful rental increases
- Issue rules and regulations in compliance with the Rent Control Ordinance
- Provide information to Tenants and Landlords
- Enforce Legislation involving Rent stabilization where allowable
- Make determinations in the interest of the City of Perth Amboy
