NOTICE OF MEETING

Regular Meeting of the Council of the City of Perth Amboy was held on Wednesday, May 14, 2014 in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Perth Amboy, New Jersey at 7:00 p.m.

Presiding Officer of the Council, Joel Pabon, Sr. advised the audience that notice of this meeting has been filed with the Home News Tribune, The Star Ledger, The Amboy Guardian and posted on the bulletin board in the City Clerk's office and on the City's website, indicating that today's meeting is being held at the Council Chambers, City Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

Stan Sierakowski, 679 Charles St.: Does the County support these two bills? Maybe there will be less politics if it goes to the County. What is the reason for this?

Greg Fehrenbach: The League is opposed to these two bills. They want to wait to see the results of the two pilot counties that are currently trying this out.

Stan Sierakowski: Was an appraisal made 2 years ago and what was the amount? The lot was used as a parking lot for years. Did we collect any rent? It's still being used as a parking lot. Why aren't we collecting rent?

Greg Fehrenbach: There was an initial interest in the property a while ago. We sent out a standard letter regarding the property. The party was not interested in paying the amount we were seeking. We did not make determinations on the 100×100 lot to fence it or restrict activity or create a problem for surrounding businesses by not allowing them to use it. We did not have funds to prepare it as a rental lot. We once again received a statement of interest and sent out another letter. We asked the parties what would be the maximum amount they would be willing to pay for this property. Based on the Assessor's sales numbers, the maximum amount to be offered was competitive in that particular market. We are seeking authorization from the Council to sell the property. We will be seeking sealed bids for the property. The property has 2 interested parties. We have set a minimum price. We want to turn it into a taxable piece of property.

PUBLIC PORTION (5 MINUTES MAXIMUM PER SPEAKER)

John Siberry, 432 Barclay St., read a letter into the record questioning the ethics of Councilman Ken Gonzalez's potential immoral, unethical and perhaps illegal conduct in the use of a handicapped placard and for his representation of clients in real estate transactions under the "First Time Homebuyer" program.

Council Member Gonzalez to Mark Blunda, Esq.: I requested the Law Dept. to research the issue of citizens applying for grants and whether there would be a conflict for me to represent them in real estate transactions.

Mark Blunda, Esq.: A sitting councilman, who is an attorney and has no vote in the granting of funds for "First Time Homebuyers", has no conflict in doing real estate closings.

Stan Sierakowski, 679 Charles St.: Mr. Blunda should not have given an opinion. This should have been referred to the Bar Ethics Committee. The City was issued the license to for a local access station. The Bd. of Ed. is only running it. Who decides what programs should be on the local access stations? The Council should determine what is on the cable station.

Jane Herron, 519 Groom St.: We live in a residential area. It is a light traffic street. We have a lot of trucks, ambulances and school buses coming down our street. We have a lot of speeding. There is no traffic enforcement on Groom & Neville Streets. There have been multiple accidents at the intersection of Groom, & Neville. I am asking for enforcement to be established in that area. There is a large pot-hole outside my window that also needs to be addressed.

Greg Fehrenbach: If that information can be provided to me in writing we will try to take care of the issues.

Ken Balut, 359 Bruck Ave.: You should include developers in the contractor ordinance. Councilman Irizarry voted for Chief Ruiz's raise, but he didn't vote for the increase for the young kids on the Police Dept. I'm still wondering why. We are an accredited police department. They should be above the law. Why are we negotiating with the Kushner people? They are criminals. All of these issues are ethical issues.

Fernando Gonzalez, 129 High St.: Three of our police officers are being honored for valor and should be acknowledged. Do we have 2 police boats and 1 fire boat now?

Greg Fehrenbach: Yes, we have a total of 3 boats.

Fernando Gonzalez: We should consider hiring additional firefighters to man the boat. You need to have a meeting with this community and expose what occurred in the Dixon Rodriguez shooting.

David Caba, 139 Lewis St.: I still believe there was no investigation in the Dixon Rodriguez shooting. Did the crossing guard that was in the area ever get contacted regarding this shooting? The answer is "no". There was no fairness in the investigation. I don't believe the City has a Grade-A rating.

Alan Silber, 244 Rector St.: The Prosecutor was biased in his investigation of the Dixon Rodriguez shooting. I hope we are doing a review so that we don't have problems like this in the future. The City Council has equal opportunity to place meetings on the local access channel. The Council should place a resolution on the agenda and vote on whether to show meetings. We need to know why Mr. Irizarry voted on one salary ordinance and not on another salary ordinance. The April 23, 2014 Council Meeting was never shown on the local access cable channel.

Greg Fehrenbach: I'll look into it.

COUNCIL COMMENTS

Council Member Nanton: There will be a Fado-Tango project in June. It is being sponsored by the Recreation Dept. The Barge Restaurant is having a ribbon cutting for their patio on Saturday afternoon.

Council Member Petrick: Not all the fire hydrants are being flushed every year.

Greg Fehrenbach: I'll look into it.
